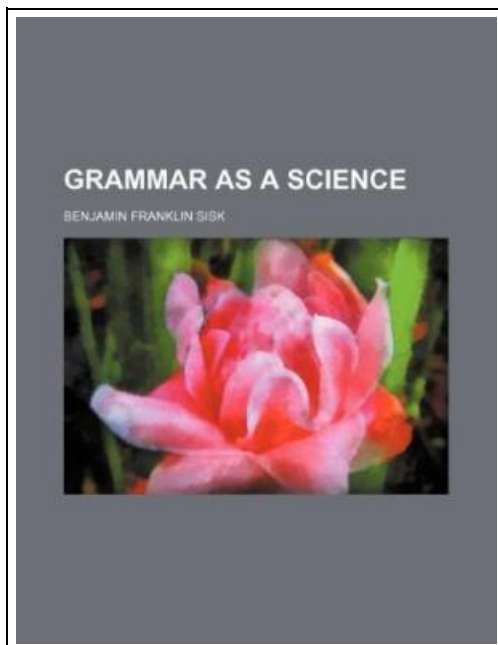

Some adverbs add the suffixes er and est to the positive form to make the comparative and the superlative forms; as, 267. The following adverbs are often used as adjectives. They are either irregular or defective in their comparison: Note 1.--Further and furthest are now generally used to express something additional without reference to space; farther and farthest are used when referring to distance in space. Note 2.--Rather is the comparative form of an old adjective rathe, meaning early. Rathe was used both as an adjective and as an adverb; as, 1. Bring the rathe primrose that forsaken dies.--Milton. 2. Why rise ye up so...
