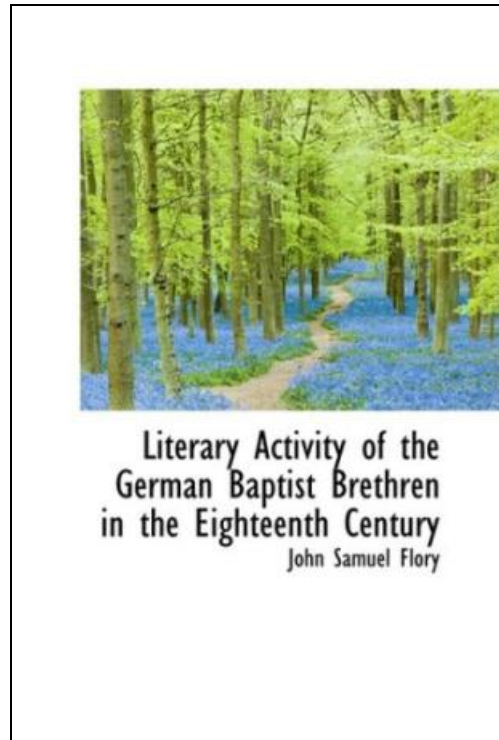

I believe one eternal, only, allpowerful, every where-present God, as he has revealed himself in the Old Testament as the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; in the New Volume, however, as the Father, Son and Spirit, Matt. 28, v. 19, and I do not find it in my soul necessary to dispute or criticise much about it: but I regard it better to submit ones self humbly to this eternal Godly Being in the Father, Son, and Spirit and to experience his inner workings, as the Father reveals the Son inwardly...
