Thus, on January 5 Attkins found Thymiamata shaded near CM., and very yellow. It was also shaded on March 16, but, very bright on March 21 between CM. and terminator. Kibbler drew it white on April 28. Molesworth only very slightly shaded. Late in the apparition it was slightly shaded N. of Cantabras; the portion S. of Cantabras appearing as a bright circular patch. Phillips saw the whole area shaded on January 5 (Plate III., Fig. 1). The bright circular patch on S. end of Thymiamata, to which Molesworth calls attention, was seen also by Attkins. Aeria...
