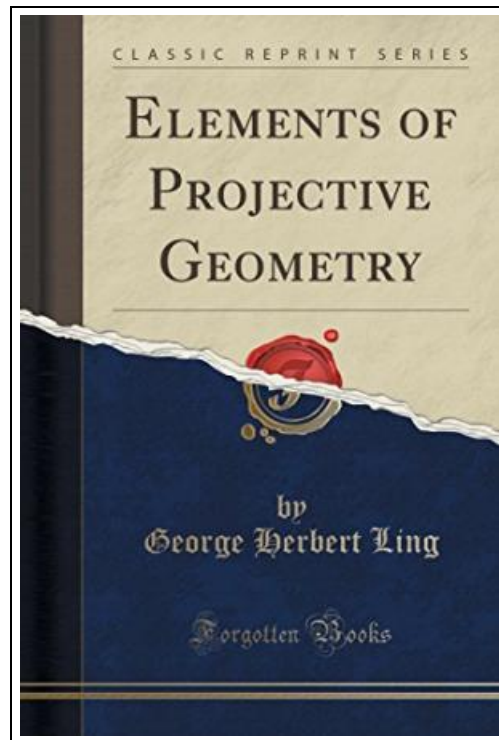

Although the value of the subject to the second of these classes has not as yet been duly recognized in America, European teachers for several decades have realized its usefulness as a theoretical basis for some of the practical work in this field. For the large number of students belonging to the third class, trigonometry, analytic geometry, and projective geometry are the three subjects essential to a fair knowledge of elementary geometry, and it is believed that the presentation given in this book is such as greatly to aid the future teacher. There is a healthy and growing feeling in America that teachers of secondary mathematics need a more thorough training in the subject matter, even at the expense of some of the theory of education which they now have.
