While studies have found that differences between men and women in math and science achievement test scores have decreased over the years, men continue to outscore women in these disciplines. In some cases, the differences were quite small. For example, among 12th graders who took the 1996 National Assessment of Educational Progress test, average math scores for men and women were 305 and 303, respectively; the average science scores were 152 and 148. In other cases, the differences were larger. For example, the National Science Foundations 1999 study shows that 1996 Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) math scores for men averaged 527 (from 520 in 1991), while SAT math scores for women averaged 492 11 (from 482 in 1991).
