Like other books in the series, Basements Complete is largely a how-to book, but with some coverage of design and planning issues. The book covers the most popular remodeling approaches and projects for basements. Some of the projectssuch as flooring, plumbing, and wiringapply to other rooms in the house but are treated here with an eye toward basement needs. And there are also topics that apply specifically to basements, such as preventing mold and mildew, moving pipes up or over to make more headroom, bringing more light into a dark space, mitigating against radon, and sealing floors and walls.
