Within these sections, contributors discuss a range of poetry, including War poetry, Irish women's poetry, Scottish women's poetry, anthologies of birth poetry, Caribbean epic poetry, and science and poetry . Contemporary poets such as Eavan Boland, Jean Binta Breeze, Jackie Kay, Denise Riley, Liz Lochhead and Grace Nichols are also given detailed attention.
