Now, the great object of the Ancient Easter Canons (Art. 41) was that this Festival should be celebrated as nearly as possible at the same time of the year as the original event which it commemorated took place; that is, at the same time of year as the Jewish Passover; not, however, before the Passover, because it would be absurd to commemorate the Resurrection before the Passion; nor on the same day as the Passover, for this would be to symbolize with the hated Jews, and to adopt the Easter practice of the heretical Quartodecimans: but as nearly as possible after the Passion. In order to avoid celebrating Easter before the Passover, it was necessary so to arrange the New Moons of the cycle, or Calendar New Moons (indicated by the Golden Numbers) that the 14th day of the...
