

Savariroyan, and was published between 1907-and 1914. The complete set is in 12 thin volumes. The set contains many erudite articles on various well-known and not so well known aspects of southern India. Volume One contains articles on: Bharat land or "Dravidian India; the solar and lunar races; ode to Cheruman Perum C. U. Cheralathan; the relation of the Pandavas to the Tamilian kings; and, on the words Chera and Kerala. Volume Two contains a lengthy dissertation on the critical review of the story of the Ramayana, and an account of south Indian castes Volume Three contains a descriptive article on: some mile-stones of Tamil Literature, or the age of Tirujnana-Sambadha, by P. Sundaram Pillai; it contains a biographical sketch of the author. Volume Four contains articles on Manikka Vacagar and his date; and on...
