it fitting to refer to the Report of the Royal Commission appointed to enquire into matters relating  
to the University of Toronto. I pointed out that the Commission consisted of seven residents of  
Toronto. Most of whom are graduates or closely identified with the University itself; that they had  
reached unanimous conclusions and had prepared a bill embodying in detail the provisions of a  
scheme which they strongly recommended the Government to carry out. The Report issued by the  
Royal Commission, dated the fourth of the present month, deals only with matters appertaining to  
the University of Toronto, the Colleges affiliated there with and School of Practical Science, all  
within the City of Toronto. I expressed to Convocation the hope that the enquiry would be  
extended to all similar institutions of...
