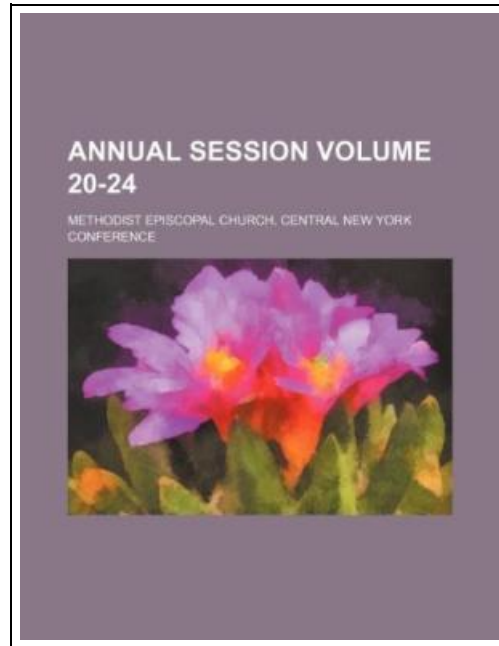

At the age of nineteen he began teaching school, which occupation he followed during the winter months for several years, working on a farm during the summer. In 1840 he married Olive R.
