The highest figure of the year for Wheat was reached August 16, 1869. Gold was but 134 with No. 1 Spring 81 70 per bushel at that time. The quantity in sight was below three million bushels, with an active speculation in Liverpool, where No. 2 Spring advanced to 100. Per ceutal. At the time of the greatest accumulation of stock (the first week in January 1870) No. 1 Spring was worth \$1 28 in currency, with gold at 122, showing that then, in spite of all the adverse influences which a close money market and vast accumulations in our own and the British markets, (aggregating bushels at the commencement of the current calendar year), the price of the best spring wheat remained above a dollar per...
