Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census compiles and publishes the Land and Water acreage of land and water in the United States every 10 years. These area figures, Area Updated available by state and county, are accepted and used by FIA in Portland, Oregon, as the gross number of acres to be inventoried in each county. The previous inventory was based on 1980 census data, and the current inventory uses 1990 census figures. Raster-scanned topographic maps from the U. S. Department of the Interior, Geological Survey and a geographic information system are now used by the Bureau of the Cen-sus to identify water bodies and landforms and to determine the size of much smaller areas than previously possible. As a result, the definition of inland water was changed to reflect the finer resolution. Streams with a minimum width of 200 feet are now recog-nized, compared to 660 feet in...
