


The U.S.-Africa Leadership Summit Seven Months Later: Progress and Setbacks (Paperback)

In addition, sub-Saharan Africa s consumer base of nearly 1 billion people is rapidly growing and has the potential to create increased demand for U.S. goods, services, and technologies. U.S. private-sector interest in tapping the economic potential of the continent is increasing, though our presence lags behind many of our partners and competitors in Europe and Asia.
