John Burroughs offers these delightful reminiscences of Theodore Roosevelt, which center on their ramble through America s first national park and their shared joy in the region s wildlife and geologic wonders. The two observed gophers, badgers, elk, mountain sheep, black-tailed deer, and birds of all kinds while camping in picturesque wilderness settings. I found his interest in bird life very keen, and his eye and ear remarkably quick, notes Burroughs of his friend, adding, His training as a big-game hunter stood him in good stead, but back of that were his naturalist s instincts, and his genuine love of all forms of wildlife. Burroughs account offers a splendid firsthand portrait of the larger-than-life president, recapturing Roosevelt s inexhaustible energy, infinite curiosity, and convivial personality. A second, briefer sketch recounts a visit to Sagamore Hill, the summer White House, where the President and his companion took a walk in the woods to identify local birds. Twelve historic black-and-white photographs complement this engaging memoir.
