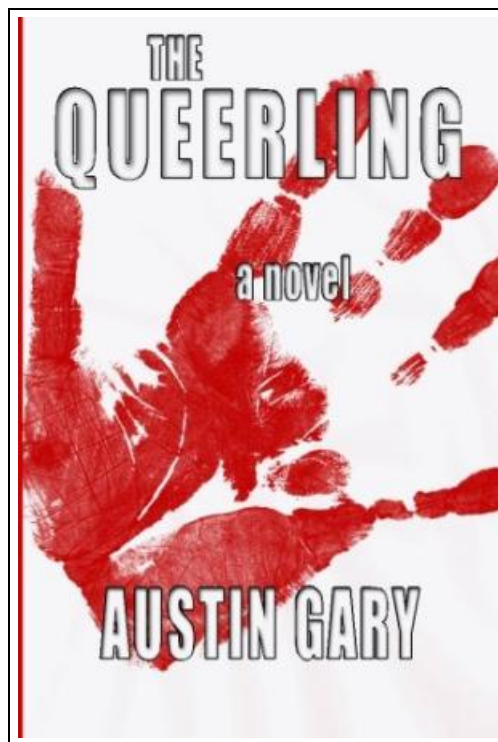

Preston Nesbitt is a 16-year-old memory prodigy, with a rare form of Aspergers Syndrome, confined to a Portland, Oregon mental hospital for refusing to admit his participation in a viral YouTube video--showing him being struck by a car that appears to pass through him. Written in the form of a journal assigned by his therapist, which he entitles, Quips and Quotes From The Queerling, Preston sees himself as both a misunderstood 21st-century Holden Caulfield and the imprisoned protagonist of Gunter Grasss classic (The Tin Drum), Oskar Matzerath, who refused to grow up in an insane world. A savant, whose life has been a series of psychologically damaging misunderstandings--by his parents, teachers and peers--Preston informs his therapist, Doc, just so you know. . . I dont trust anyone who doesnt drop the occasional F-bomb. His rants--mini arias sparing no one--include indictments of society and its various constructs; over-medication of Americas youth, specifically The Drug War on Children; and what he believes to be an elementary, limited understanding of Reality, comparable to learned men once believing the world to be flat and to the medical professions primitive use of blood-letting. With sardonic, cultural reference-heavy humor, off-the-charts genius, and emotion-laden memories, Preston questions demand answers. In his world, memories and dreams occupy the same temporal plane as any other reality. Out-Of-Body Experiences, shape-shifting and past-life recollections are important facets of his unique personality. In Prestons world, queerness isnt merely confined to sexual identity. Far from it!
