Excerpt from Fifty-First Annual Meeting of the Maryland State Teachers Association, 1918 The fifty-first annual meeting of the Maryland State Teachers Association was called to order at 10.30 a. m. on Friday, November 29, by President Orem at the Western High School, Baltimore. The meeting opened with the singing of the Star-Spangled Banner. The invocation was offered by the Rev. Charles H. Pinchbeck, of the Seventh Baptist Church of Baltimore. Hon. James F. Thrift represented Mayor Preston, of Baltimore, in welcoming the teachers to the city. The response to the address of welcome was delivered by Dr. M. Bates Stephens, State Superintendent of Education, Baltimore. A selection was then rendered by the pupils from the Western High School, under the direction of Miss Jessie L. Armstrong, assistant supervisor of music, Baltimore city. This was followed by an address by Dr. William Chandler Bagley, professor of education. Teachers College, Columbia University. President Orem appointed a committee, consisting of Dr. Henry S. West, principal of the Maryland State Normal School; James B. Noble, county superintendent in Dorchester County; Dr....
