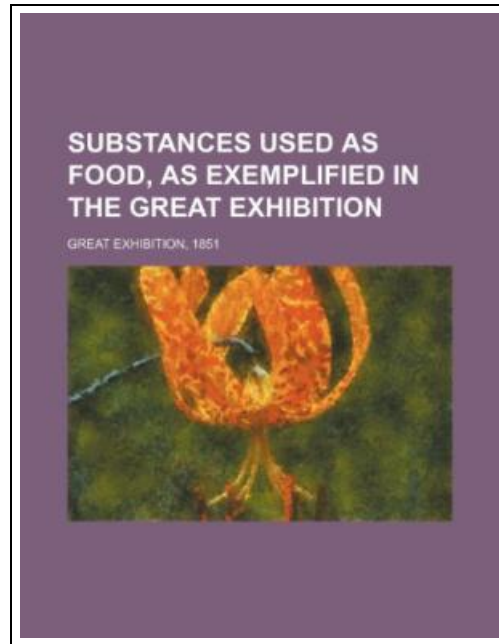

There can be little doubt that the excessive duty placed upon tea ia a prominent cause of these adulterations at home; for it is not to be supposed for a moment that if genuine tea could be sold at 1s. 6d. per pound, instead of 3s. or 4. which is the present price of the commoner kinds, that any adulteration of the sort in question would be practised. Among the inhabitants of South America, what is called Paraguay tea,1 is almost as extensively used as the Chinese tea is amongst us and in China. Throughout Brazil, Uruguay, Paraguay, the Plate district, Chili and Peru, this tea is universally employed; and is commonly known under the term Mate. It is the leaf of a shrub, Ilex Paraguayensis. This shrub grows wild in Brazil and Paraguay, and not less than 5,000,000 pounds of the leaves are annually collected in the latter country and are sent to Chili and Buenos Ayres. The preparation of the plant by the natives greatly differs from that of the tea-plant by the Chinese. While the latter are so particular as to use the most minute precautions in the drying and manufacture of the tea-leaves, the natives of Paraguay...
