It will be noted in fig. 7 that each calorimeter is not provided with an entirely independent set of connections, but that the chair calorimeter and calorimeter No. 4 are connected in parallel, as are also calorimeters Nos. 3 and 5. This is allowable because other considerations prevent the calorimeters thus joined from ever being used at the same time. It will be seen that the method as described is approximate only,...
