

After general discussion of ways and means by the five members present, a duecard was adopted, Voted to have an assessment of ten cents per month, per member, to pay expenses. Voted to hold annual election of officers on December 7th, 1904. Messrs. Walter Angell and Harry A. Cash were elected honorary members. William Dearden exhibited specimens of butterflies and Noctuids in the Riker mounts. Messrs. Nylan, Billson and Keith also exhibited insects. The meeting adjourned at 10 P. M. E. D. Keith, Secy. Dec. 7th, 1904 The annual meeting was called to order by President Billson at 9 P. M. Minutes of meeting of Nov. 10th were read and approved, and the following officers were elected for 1905: President, James E. Billson; Vice-President, William Dearden; Secretary, C. Abbott Davis; Treasurer, E. D. Keith. President Billson exhibited a box of Noctuids, and Mr. Dearden exhibited a fine collection (in Riker mounts) of R. I. insects as follows: P. Vitis, C. Tersa, T. Modesta S. astylus (very rare), H. gracilis and a species of the AEGRIDAE; also a series of S. A. Morphos, and some hybrid Bombacids of his own rearing. The publication of the APTERYX was discussed, and meeting adjourned at 10 P. M. Ten present. C. Abbott Dav1s, Secretary. Dec. 28th, 1904. Pres. Billson called the meeting...
