A single bank of two elevators served all floors except the mechanical penthouse. At least one hotel guest reported that he left the building was not equipped with automatic sprinklers. A standpipe for occupant use (Class II according to NFPA 14, Standpipe and Hose Systems) was provided. A single 6-inch riser supplied one hose station on each floor from the basement through the fifth floor. Above the fifth floor the water supply split into two 4-inch risers to supply hose outlets on each floor. The mechanical penthouse had a single hose station supplied from one of the 4-inch standpipe risers. Each hose station was equipped with 100 feet of 1-1...
