After a wonderfully calm passage across the Bay of Biscay the ship anchored at Gibraltar at 6-30 p.m. on the following Monday. We had to content ourselves with seeing the lights of the town, as it was too late to land. Leaving about midnight for Marseilles, we next morning found ourselves skirting the African coast, and in the distance could see the mountains covered with snow. Marseilles was reached on the succeeding Thursday morning, where the ship stayed a few hours and those who wished had time to visit the town. Here we picked up the overland passengers, including Prince Henri of Orleans, and an Italian count who could speak seven languages, including Arabic, and was the most inveterate gambler I ever met with.
