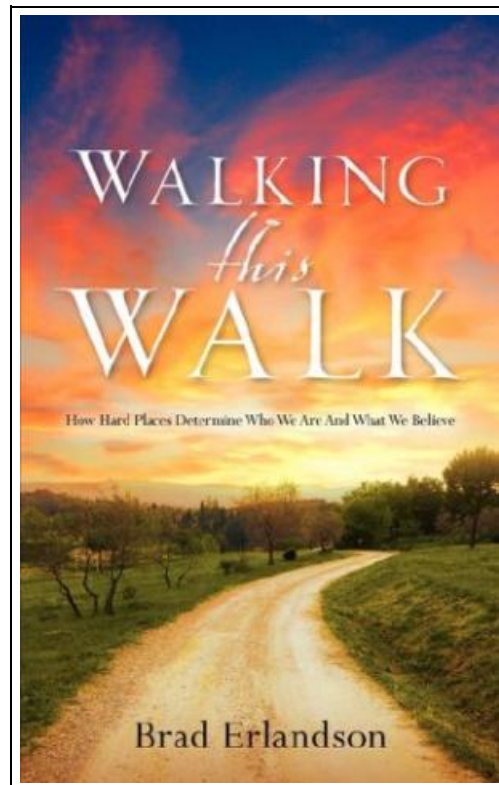

Through all the physical and emotional pain, his quest for knowing and loving God through Jesus Christ has continued, as well as his call to teach and share the Word of God with others. Erlandson holds a B. A. in Theology from Toccoa Falls College and a M. A. in Religion from Liberty Universty. Quotes from Walking This Walk: Being in hard places forces us to determine what we really believe and who we really are. Life can cause you to go deeper or give up, to get bitter or become better. God is always looking at what is going on inside when things are falling apart on the outside. Every prayer Jesus prayed was answered because He asked according to Gods will. Sometimes we ask things that are Biblically appropriate, but are not Gods will for that moment. Know that it is about the heart and about your reaction to the whole storm that has come upon you. If you caused the storm, all the more, you must hold on...
