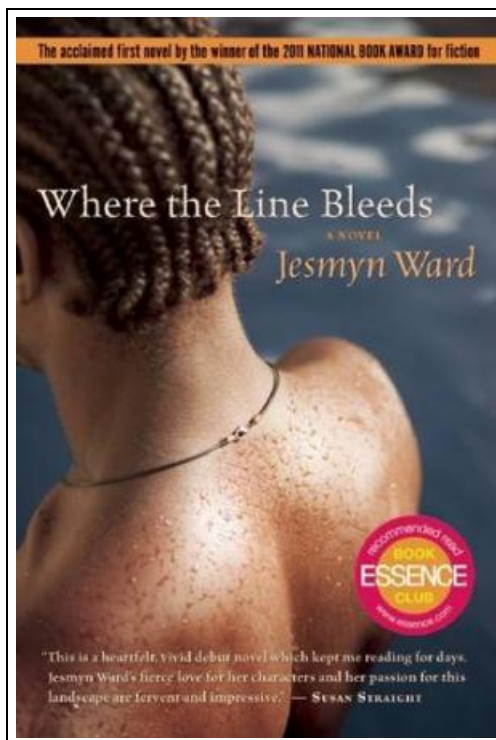

Ward inhabits these characters, and this world—black Creole, poor, and drug-riddled, yet shored by family and community to a rare degree, without a trace of irony or distance."
