It is obvious that a scientific arrangement, in which constructions were grouped according to their natural relationship, however valuable for purposes of reference, would be of little use in teaching Composition. In such an arrangement constructions must necessarily be classified without regard to their difficulty or the rarity of their occurrence, and the attempt to follow such an order would involve the premature introduction of difficulties and the undue postponement of some of the easiest and most ordinary constructions. While, however, it is impossible that the practical should exactly coincide with the logical order, it is highly desirable that both pupil and teacher should be conscious of some method in the order adopted. An attempt has accordingly been made in this book to effect a compromise between the logical and the practical. Part I. is a reprint of the English Latin Exercises in First...
