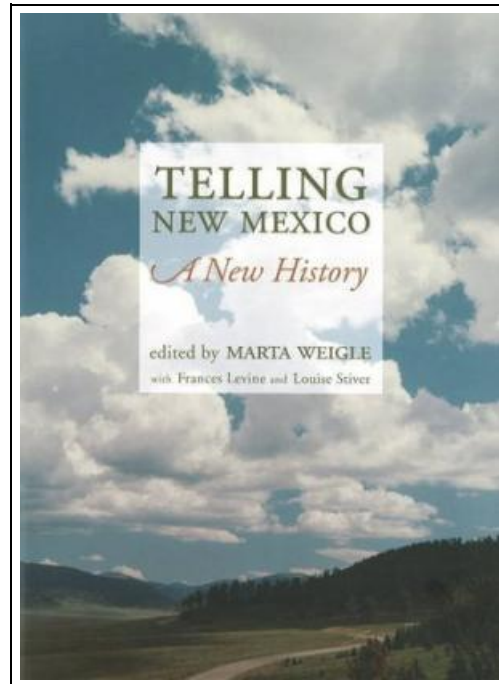


Telling New Mexico: A New History.

Among her numerous New Mexico books are Alluring New Mexico: Engineered Enchantment, 1821-2001 and Spanish New Mexico: The Spanish Colonial Arts Society Collection (both Museum of New Mexico Press) and the co-authored The Lore of New Mexico (University of New Mexico Press). Frances Levine is director of the New Mexico History Museum/Palace of the Governors. Louise Stiver is the former senior curator of the New Mexico History Museum/Palace of the Governors.
