The tract Propositiones De Motu is memorable as marking the point at which Newton had arrived about the end of 1684; it contains the chief propositions given in his lectures of that year, as also two or three theorems on motion in a resisting medium. The tract contains eleven propositions, preceded by three definitions, a statement of four hypotheses or assumptions, and two lemmas. The proofs are geometrical. The propositions are as...
