




Interview with Maj Matthew Gomez

MAJ Matthew Gomez served as assistant Support Operations Officer (SPO) in Baghdad, Iraq during 2003 and 2004, company commander in Baghdad, Iraq during 2005 and 2006, as operations and logistics officer in Kirkuk, Iraq during 2007 and 2008 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) and as Support Operations Officer in Mazar e Sharif, Afghanistan during 2010 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF). In this February 2011 interview, MAJ Gomez discusses the various duty positions he held and the challenges of each, the changes he noted in Iraq over the course of five years and three deployments, and the challenges of carrying out logistics operations in northern Afghanistan.
