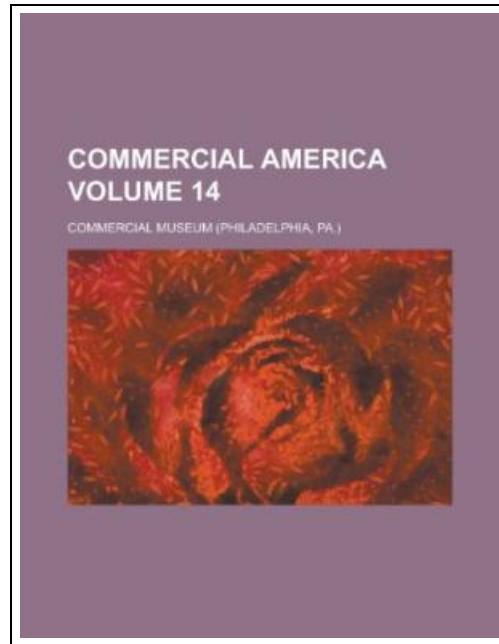

American countries have been sending direct to the United States, some of them through the Panama Canal, goods which have heretofore gone to Europe and been reexported to this country from England, Holland, Germany and France. Owing to the fact that the United States is building, primarily for use in the war, over 2, 000, 000 tons of shipping, it will, if the war continues for any length of time, have a larger mercantile marine than any other country in the world except the United Kingdom. This will make it possible for trade between the United States and foreign countries to be carried on in American bottoms. Much trade that has heretofore gone to Europe will therefore come direct to the United States, and large quantities of raw materials, as rubber, nitrates, jute, silk, wool, hides and skins, and food products, such as coffee, sugar and tea, will no longer go to London warehouses and be reshipped. The President of the United States has just issued an order requiring licenses from the Government for all exports and imports. The effect of this proclamation upon the quantity and the value of foreign trade cannot be forecast at this time, but it may be taken for granted that in administering the law every care will be taken to prevent a sacrifice of private interests. That will only be done where it is felt to be necessary to prevent some danger to the common welfare. According to..
