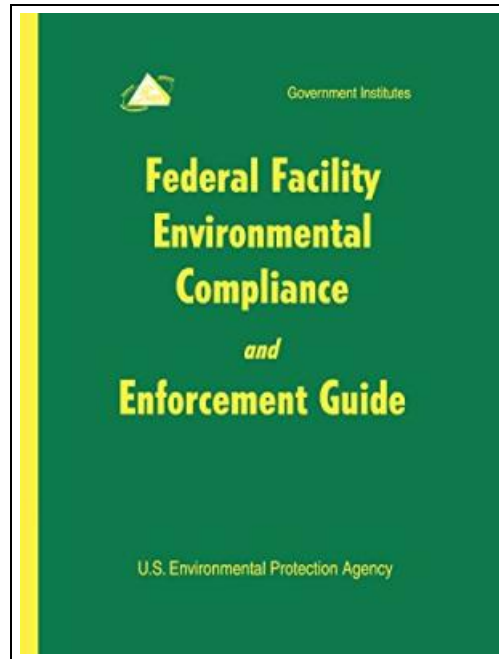

Summaries of the most recent executive orders are also included.
