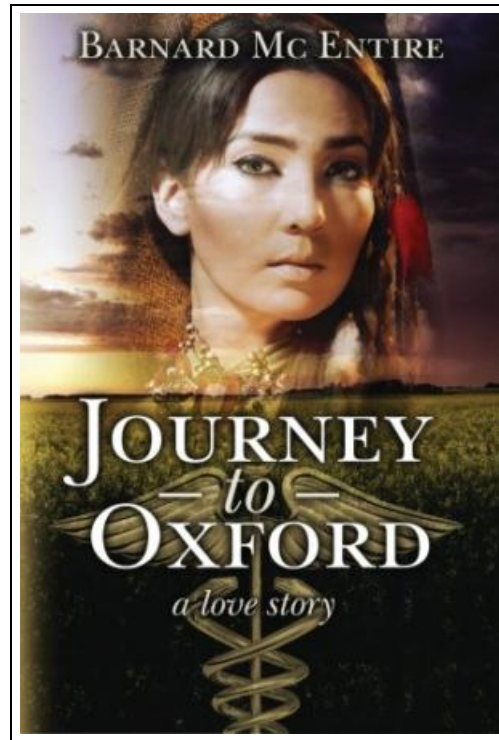

During an age of primitive medicine, he reaches the skill level of most physicians by the time hes seventeen. His dream is to attend Oxford Universitys medical college in England. But before he can leave, cholera kills his family, except for his mother. Later shes murder by men who see an opportunity to steal the family fortune. Nat escapes west with legal papers needed by the killers. Circumstances force his slave Jeremiah to escape with him. Along the way, young Briggs inadvertently rescues a teenage girl from a brutal owner. Secawas quick learning stuns him and the frontiersmen helping Nat escape to safety. Nearly everyone thinks its a trick, dismissing her as a clever Indian. But not Nat. He recognizes her exceptional intelligence and encourages her learning. For the first time in years, she feels safe. During the following two years, Nat passes the Armys medical boards and becomes an Assistant Surgeon at Fort Laramie. Secawa serves as his interpreter when he is assigned to give medical aid to the native tribes. Together they experience danger, laughter and tender young love. Then the time comes when Nat and Jeremiah must return to confront the man who murdered Nats mother and holds Jeremiahs family in bondage. Afterward, Nathaniel plans to go on to Oxford. Secawa is told she cannot go with him for her safety and because the university will reject him if they discover hes married to a person of color. Secawa is determined not to let him go without her.
