Killer cops and cop-killers, police as workers and police as soldiers, copwatching and counterinsurgency operations. these subjects and more are examined in this collection of essays by veteran activist Kristian Williams, released to mark ten years since the first publication of his book *Our Enemies in Blue* in 2004. In section one, focusing in on police murders in Portland, Seattle, and Oakland, *Fire the Cops!* examines the relationship between working-class communities (predominantly Black) and the police, showing how police violence and impunity function to buttress the power of the State, and arguing that the left should recognize the political content of much of the violence directed against police. Next, in section two, Williams traces the history of the sometimes confusing relationship between the police and organized labor, from the age of the Pinkertons to the much publicized involvement of police in the protests against Wisconsin Governor Scott Walker in 2011, and varied police responses to the Occupy movement around the same time. Addressing claims that police are workers too, Williams shows how any instances of police acting in solidarity with the working class have been atypical, inconsistent,...
