Paul Getty Museum celebrates wine and explores the benefits and risks of its consumption. Fruits of Desire is a wonderfully illustrated volume that traces the visual and literary sources that inspired Griessmann's designs. It also looks how, although the cup's maker has long been considered a master of German Baroque ivory carving, Griessmann was only identified by name fifteen years ago.
