This study focuses on an analysis of the revised final draft FM 22-100, Army Leadership and its usefulness for unit leaders in instilling the Army core values. Within this research effort, the investigator evaluated the doctrine presented to include the framework, and character development model introduced. The doctrinal framework and model were compared to theory in the field.
