Robert Indiana, famous as a pioneering pop artist in the 1960s, and renowned for making his LOVE sculptures, paintings and posters so famous that the United States Postal Service put it on a stamp, is this year experiencing a monumental comeback in New York City with a new installation of colorful numbers along Park Avenue titled One Through Zero and simultaneous shows at CM Arts and Paul Kasmin Gallery. This volume looks at Indiana s hugely influential early Pop Art work, but focuses on his more recent and extensive work with numbers. Each of his numbers represents a phase in life and each has its own color scheme; for example, 1 is red and green and symbolizes birth, and 6 is green and red and symbolizes the peak of life.
