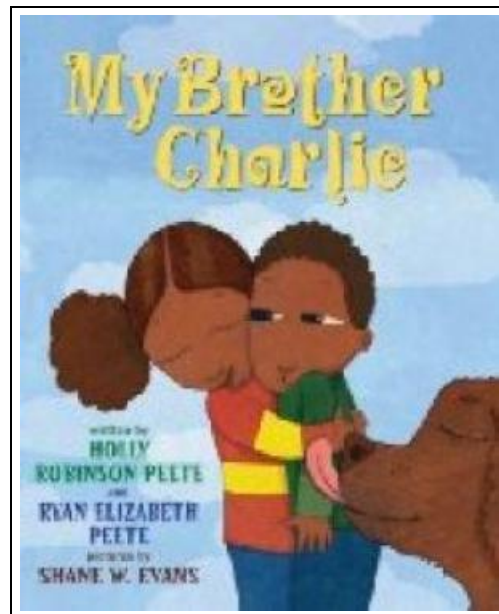

Charlie is like any other boy -- and he has autism. In this story, told from a sister's point of view, we meet a family whose oldest son teaches them important lessons about togetherness, hope, tolerance, and love. Holly Robinson Peete, bestselling author, actress, and national autism spokesperson, collaborates with her daughter, Ryan, to write this uplifting book based on their experiences with Holly's son (and Ryan's brother), RJ, who has autism. "PreSchool-Grade 2 -- Twins Callie and Charlie have a lot in common, but they are also very different: Charlie has autism. Callie narrates the story, describing what autism is and exploring the issues that come along with it. The theme is of love, patience, and acceptance. Endnotes give a few basic facts for children unfamiliar with the disorder. The authors, a mother-daughter team, based this story on personal experience. Evans's bright, mixed-media illustrations skillfully depict the family's warmth and concern. Pair this with Ouisie Shapiro's *Autism and Me: Sibling Stories* to raise awareness and understanding of autism.
