This is true of the relationship between Pakistan and India. For most of the six decades since 1947, Pakistan has been under 'one-party' (military) rule which, for its own survival and hegemony over political parties, has kept up the anti-India pot boiling in the name of national existence, liberation of Kashmir, Islam and the Ummah (the global nation of Islam). India has been ruled by successive secular, civilian parties for most of its first 60 years since independence. Paradoxically, during the brief six years of the coalition government led by the fundamentalist Bharatiya Janata Party under Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee, anti-Pakistani sentiments were at one of their lowest levels. Indeed there was an upsurge of people-to-people bonhomie -- 1999 Kargil war and 2002 Gujarat pogrom notwithstanding. Pakistan's de facto rulers (Army and its intelligence arm ISI) have long taken their allies, the USA and Saudi Arabia, for a ride and convinced them that India constitutes a threat to Pakistan's very existence.
