The American Heart Association has estimated that CVD affects 83. 6 million individuals in the U.S., contributes to 32. 3 of deaths, and is a leading cause of disability. Atherosclerosis causes coronary heart disease (CHD), cerebrovascular disease, and peripheral artery disease. Abnormal lipoprotein metabolism predisposes individuals to atherosclerosis. Due to the consistent and robust association of higher LDL-c levels with atherosclerotic CVD across experimental and epidemiologic studies, therapeutic strategies to decrease risk have focused on LDL-c reduction as a primary goal. In contrast to LDL-c, high-density lipoprotein (HDL-c) has a protective role against atherosclerotic CVD. Questions remain as to how best to modify lipid levels with the goal of preventing CHD. The 3-hydroxy-3-methylglutaryl coenzyme A (HMG-CoA) reductase inhibitors (statins) are the most widely prescribed lipid-lowering agents and are often used as monotherapy. However, some patients do not reach their treatment goals on statin monotherapy or are troubled by side effects, prompting interest in combination therapy as...
