W. Gibbes, of Columbia, S. C., to the Chair, and requesting Lieut. Patrick of the same place, to act as Secretary. The meeting was opened with prayer by Rev. Dr. Reynolds, of Columbia, S. C. The Chairman then read the following resolution, adopted by the State Educational Association of North Carolina, at their meeting, October, 1862. Resolved, That this Association recommend a general convention of the teachers of the Confederate States, to be held at on 1863, to take into consideration the best means for supplying the necessary text-books for schools and colleges, and for uniting their efforts for the advancement of education in the Confederacy; and that the Executive Committee of the Association be directed to correspond with teachers in the various States on the subject.
