The first paper in Volume II (Memoire sur quelques problems cubiques et biquadratiques) was a prize memoir for which, conjointly with another memoir, the Steinder Prize of the Berlin Academy was awarded. This publication also includes a Biographical Sketch by Charles H. Pearson; Recollections of Henry J.S. Smith by Jowett, Lord Bowen, J.L. Strachan-Davidson and Alfred Robinson; Introduction to the Mathematical Papers by the Editor, J.W.L. Glaisher.
