Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Lieutenant Colonel (P) Sharon Leary served as the commander of the 115th Forward Support Battalion which is part of the 1st Brigade Combat Team, 1st Cavalry Division, during her March 2004 through March 2005 deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. She was primarily responsible for logistical supplies. Predeployment training included rotating units through professional development classes based on information being fed back out of theater with the goal of a seamless battle handoff. Her area of responsibility included the east side of Baghdad - east of the Tigris River and up against the Diyala River. A problem with base locations was that the compounds have Iraqi neighborhoods fairly close to them, leading to a base defense problem. Multiple mortar and rocket attacks led to building segregation and separation lots for supplies to minimize collateral damage from attacks. Her initial deployment impressions included a belief that our Army s reliance on third country nationals and host nation support would take over the first hundred miles of the supply system and then leave the last 10 tactical miles up...
