M. an alarm sent from the box located at Charlton and West streets was received by the Department, calling the 7floating engine to the scene of the fire in addition to the usual complement of three engine and two hook and ladder companies. A third alarm at 2.28 A. M. brought eight engine and two hook and ladder companies more, but one of the engine companies, not being required, was at once returned to quarters. The structure occupied the whole of Pier 36, 75x600 feet, was two stories high for about one hundred feet from the bulkhead and built of wood with iron roof trusses, the whole covered with corrugated iron.
