The flowers usually solitary, are large, yellow or orange, and rather short-lived. But the plants bloom constantly, and as the foliage is good, too, they are used for these reasons. Choose an open, sunny place with good garden soil for the Horned Poppies. They may be raised from the seed or by division of old plants. Start the seeds indoors in February. Transplant to the garden in May and allow eight inches f space between the plants. WITCH HAZEL (Hamamelis virginiana) Witch Hazel is most attractive in the fall, because,...
