J., Forest township; died of tuberculosis of the peritoneum November 10, 1911. He left a group of 6 people, all of whom show evidence of infection. Group 25: Center case; M. W., Morristown village; died of pulmonary tuberculosis November 17, 1911. Of the group of 5 surrounding her at the time of her death 4 show evidence of infection and 1 is negative, but there are other likely sources of infection of this group. Group 26:...
