

If secretion means every alteration by the tissue-cells of the medium in which they live either by the removal from it of all the materials required for their nutrition, or by the return to it of all the products of their metabolism we should obviously have to admit that every living cell, as such, exhibits secretory activity (Brown-Sequard). But the concept of secretion must be taken in a more restricted sense.
