The Well-Beloved: A Sketch of a Temperament is a novel by Thomas Hardy, serialized in 1892, and published as a book in 1897. The main setting of the novel, the Isle of Slingers, is based on the Isle of Portland in Dorset, southern England. Many of Hardy s novels were set in Dorset. The Well Beloved is one of Hardy s last novels. It was first published in three-part serial form in 1892, and then revised and re-published as a book in 1897, after Hardy s last novel Jude the Obscure (1895). The novel tells the story of the sculptor Jocelyn Pierston s search for the ideal woman, through three generations of a Portland family. A cottage housing what is now part of Portland Museum, on the Isle of Portland, founded by Marie Stopes, a friend of Hardy and his wife, was an inspiration for the book. The cottage acted as the home of Avice, the novel s heroine. Thomas Hardy, OM (2 June 1840 - 11 January 1928) was an English novelist and poet. A Victorian realist in the tradition of George...
