Wyer, to be submitted to the New York State Library School as the bibliographic thesis in partial fulfillment of the requirements for the B. L. S. degree. The catalogued and uncatalogued material in the Williams College Library forms the basis of the bibliography. It has been examined in detail. The Berkshire Athenaeum, Boston Public Library, Library of Congress, Massachusetts Historical Society Library, Massachusetts State Library, New York Public Library and the New York State Library have been searched for additional data. The subject readings under which the material is grouped are those indicated in Dewey s Decimal Classification in the section for colleges and universities. The incompleteness of the collection covered by this bibliography is apparent to no one more than it is to the compiler. But with...
