

Bullying is an age-old problem that has traditionally been seen as normal, as par-for-the-course of childhood and youth, at times even depicted as a rite-of-passage with character building benefits. Faye Mishna and Melissa Van Wert provide a well-organized, multidimensional overview of bullying in this introductory text, the first book of its kind to look specifically at the Canadian context. Drawing on the most up-to-date research, including the Health Behavior in School-Age Children survey and recent parliamentary reviews, Mishna and Van Wert consider specific facts about Canada. These include societal norms and characteristics, marginalization of certain communities, immigration and diversity, socioeconomic indicators, and urban-rural demographics, all factors that can influence bullying dynamics. The authors also consider other potential contributors, such as physical appearance, learning abilities or developmental challenges, sexual orientation, and family dynamics. Mishna and Van Wert devote an entire chapter to the latest research on cyber bullying, a relatively new problem that has arisen in the wake of social media and information and communication technologies.
