The boundary rivers are the Mississippi, the Ohio and the Wabash. Its area is variously given 55,410 to 50,050 square miles. The population is about 3,000,000. The average elevation is 600 feet above the sea level, 290 feet in the south and 1000 feet in the extreme north. The length is estimated by different authorities as 380 to 388 miles, the width 212 to 218 miles. The navigable rivers are the Mississippi, Ohio Wabash, Illinois, Kaskaskia and Rock. The Illinois and Michigan canal connects the Illinois river and Lake Michigan. There are about 8000 miles of railroad. The estimated area of Illinois coal fields is 35,000 square miles.
