I have therefore added the following parts for the horn starting from the bar in question. p cresc. ff This is not absolutely necessary, but it seems rather strange to hear this passage which is raised a tone (ismajor in contradistinction to the preceding D major) without the ring of the horns, and to be forced to say that doubtless it was only a technical hindrance which caused this omission. The artistic conscience of the conductor must be the guide as to whether my suggestion should be adopted or not. Page 14, bars 9–16. For a careful performance I propose the following notation for violas and violins: VC Page 15, bars 4 and 5. The second horn plays the lower D. Page 16, bars 2 and 4. The trill should be taken without grace-note...
